### Dear Friends,

Our family had the pleasure of sharing in a Navy change of command/retirement service at Fort Jackson, S.C. Our brother-in-law, Kyle, assumed the command of the Naval Chaplain School there on post. It was an impressive service with lots of tradition and ceremony. One of the aspects of the retirement service for the Captain he replaced was "being piped overboard." Part of this tradition was being officially "relieved of the watch." Officially, of course, Kyle now stands "the watch" over the school, but the wording used was open ended, inviting all present to "stand the watch" now.

I'm sure that the actual intent was for those on active duty to stand the watch, especially the retiring Captain's son who has only begun his naval career. In fact, as a part of the service, the Captain passed his wristwatch to his son, symbolizing the passing of responsibilities and duty. I was informed later that in those exchanges between a father and son, a watch or sword were the typical symbols passed down on these occasions.

As the Captain was piped overboard, symbolically, it was not hard to be reminded of the dual "watch" you and I have, similar to the Navy, Army, and Air Force chaplains, to actively participate as Christians and Americans through our dedication and service. Unlike those in the Armed Service, our "watch" is for life, and it is just as vital. Our active duty military serve a specific and dangerous function. They serve at our behest to provide security for our country as best as humanly possible. As Christians, we know that true security on the human level is fleeting at best, even with good vigilance. True security for us comes from God in whom we can place our trust, our life, and our faith. Nations come and go through the course of history. God remains the same presence throughout that time. For people of faith, our "watch" is our lifetime. How we choose to live it and serve during it will reflect where our true hearts reside.

Our soldiers and sailors need our prayers and support. They need our faith to be strong and diligent in popular as well as unpopular times. We must stand our "watch" as they stand theirs.

Just as a sideline FYI and a plug for Brite Divinity and the Disciples, did you know that we currently have three third highest ranking military chaplains in the Army, Navy and Air Force. Besides the Chief of Chaplains (a two star Admiral) and the Chief Chaplain for the Marine Corp (a one star General), three of our Brite graduates are at the top of the next level and they all graduated within a year or two of each other from Brite. Congratulations and God's speed to Captain Kyle Fauntleroy (Navy), Colonel Mike Tarvin (Army) and Colonel Mike Grubbs (Air Force)!

On behalf of a grateful church, I want to thank you in advance for your support of the new church movement. More than 12 years ago, Rev. Richard Hamm wrote in his book 20/20 Vision, that he envisioned the creation of more than 1,000 new Disciples churches between 2001 and 2020. Many thought that this was an unachievable objective.

At Pentecost in 2011, we Disciples stand just beyond the halfway point towards our 2020 goal. I am pleased to report that the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) has started more than 692 new congregations since 2001, reaching more than 42,000 new Disciples.

One of the most recent church plants is in Prosper, Texas, where the North Texas Area of the Southwest Region has called Doug Kriz, along with his wife Meredith and two small children, to Prosper to gather a yet-to-be named community of faith. We ask your church to pray for the Kriz family and all of our new church planters as they live out their mission to help bring people in relationship with Christ. The Pentecost offering is evenly divided between the region where the offering was taken and New Church Ministry. The offering is used to directly support starting new congregations and funds the recruitment, assessment, training and coaching of our new church planters in the first two years of their new plant. We invite you to join us in expanding the new church movement by supporting these courageous leaders through prayer and financial assistance.
